All participating horses must be AMHA registered. Stallions three years old and older must have a stallion certificate in order to participate. All horses must be measured or present a valid permanent measurement card. Stalls are \$60.00 (Wednesday - Sunday close of show - two horse maximum). Additional nights are \$10.00 per night per stall. All horses must be stabled. Camper hook-up, \$25.00 per night. Valid AMHA registration, current coggins within 12 months of show date, health certificate (within 30 days) for out of state horses. **Make checks payable to Dixieland Miniature Horse Society (DMHS) and mail check and entries to: Dixi A. Any exhibitor with Special Needs is welcome to participate in all shows.

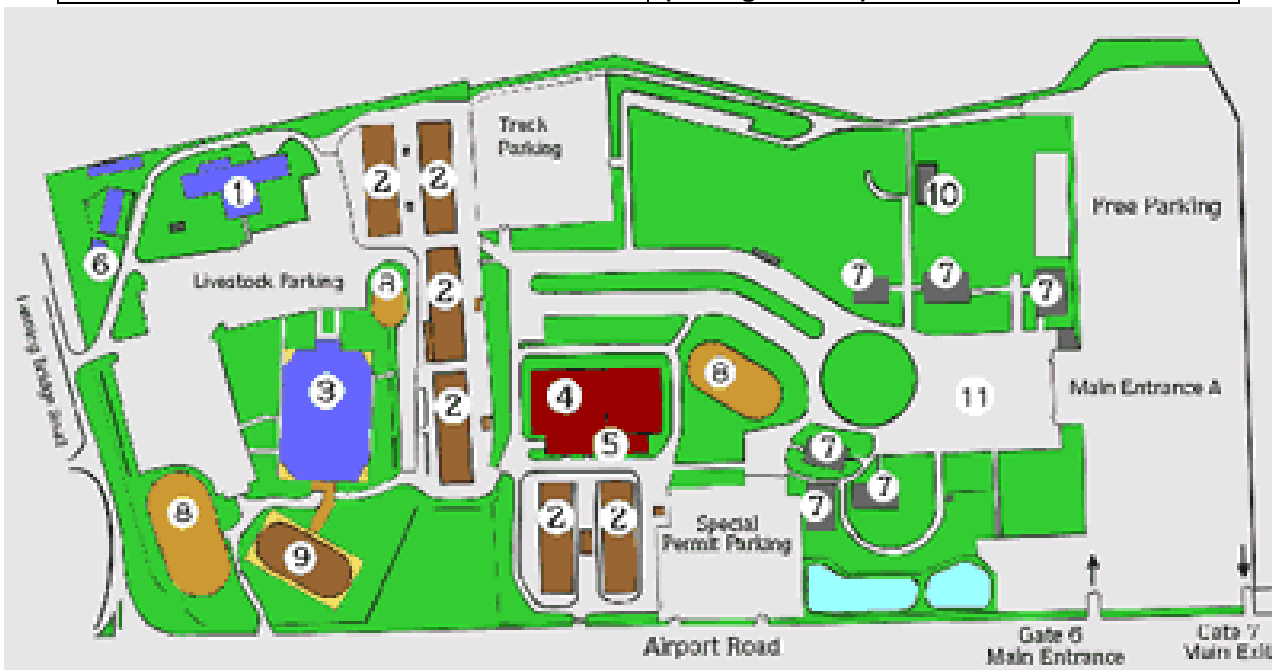

General Rules and Information

ENTRY FEES: Open & Amateur Classes - \$30.00
Youth Classes - \$15.00

NO ADDED CLASS ENTRIES FOR THE CURRENT DAY OF SHOW WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 9AM ON THE MORNING OF THAT PARTICULAR SHOW DAY. NO EXCEPTIONS!! If you need to add classes, add them the night before or before 9am!!

STALLS: \$60.00 (Wednesday-Sunday close of Show) - maximum 2 horses per stall) First bag of shavings per stall is provided free. Any additional shavings will be available on the show grounds for a fee. Stall fee is the same for tack stalls. Stall cleanings are to be dumped in designated areas ONLY. All horses must be stalled. **Early arrivals/layovers will be charged \$10.00 per stall per night.**

MEASURING: Measuring will take place on Wednesday from 3pm - 7pm; and Thursday and Friday from 8am-9am. Any late arrivals will be done as needed. All horses must be measured or present a measurement card. Please have your registration papers available for identification. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurements.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th place in each class. Certificates will be awarded to all Champions and to Supreme Halter Horses. Embroidered coolers will be awarded to the High Point Amateur, High Point Youth, and High Point Performance Horse. Embroidered totes will be awarded to Supreme Halter Horses.

VENDORS: \$100.00 per weekend show (without electric). \$200.00 for weekend with electrical hook-up.

REFUNDS: Refunds will not be given without a veterinarian's written certificate stating why the horse is unable to show. This is to be presented to the Show Manager at the show or within 7 days of the conclusion of the show. There will be NO REFUNDS on stall fees. Substitutions will be accepted without penalty. No refund on pre-paid shavings.

ENTRIES DUE: Entry deadline is June 10th, 2009. All entry forms, copies of BOTH sides of AMHA registration papers of each horse, lease agreements, copy of youth and/or Amateur cards, and a check/money order for payment of classes, stalls, AMHA fees, RV reservations, etc. are to be sent to the Show Manager, Dixi A. Cohea. Checks are to be made payable to DMHS. **Any check not honored by bank will be charged additional \$25.00 and may be referred to parent organization for disciplinary action.**

CONDUCT: Evidence of any cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment to a horse, in or out of the ring, will not be tolerated by the Show Management and shall result in disqualification of the horse and that exhibitor for the balance of that show. The offender will be barred from the show area for the duration of the show. The results shall be the forfeiture of all trophies, ribbons, awards, and points for that show. The Show Manager shall notify AMHA of any such disqualification when show results are reported.

Stall Assignments:

Stall assignments are done on a first come, first served basis by entries. I try to accommodate all requests, but can only do them as entries arrive. If you have a certain barn you would like, please get your entries and money in early to increase your chances of getting that particular location. If you were at last year's show, your stall assignment will be close to the same location if you request it.

ADD or DELETE CLASSES:

To help the show run smoothly and on time, ADD and DROP classes will have a deadline time. All additional classes will be handed into the show office **BEFORE** (before 9am) the day of that show, or the night before the show day. This will be strictly enforced. Sorry for any inconvenience, but this is only respectful to the other exhibitors and the office personnel. Please be aware of all the classes offered at the show prior to attendance.

Non-Reserved Stalls & Electric Use

Any unreserved stall that is used, whether it be to stand a horse in between classes, tack use, or otherwise, will be charged the same fee as all other stalls. Any barn electric use by vehicles/trailers will be charged the same daily fee as the RV/camper area.

COGGINS:

Required by North Carolina State Law. We were notified. QUOTE - "The WNC Agricultural Center's employees and/or Veterinarian Division Employees will be checking the certificates with each animal entering these grounds. Any equine found not in conformance of this law will be required to leave the property or the animal may be put under quarantine until a blood sample is drawn and tested for Equine Infectious Anemia. Also, the owner could be charged with a violation of the law".

Please bring with you a very eligible copy of your current coggins and health certificate (health certificate -if you are traveling from out of state). You will need to show these documents to the state inspector if and when he arrives on the show grounds.
